## NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 17.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by regulation 17 of the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953, I, the Director of Agriculture, do hereby order that sour lemons of the 1954 crop intended for export shall be cut after 6 a.m. of the 13th September, 1954.

Sour lemons cut on or after the above-mentioned date will be required to be passed as mature as prescribed in regulation 19 of the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953.

THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF KANTARA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Kantara hereby make the following bye-laws:—

- 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kantara (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kantara Byelaws, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kantara Bye-laws, 1951 and 1954.
- 2. Bye-law 181 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure "4p." and the substitution therefor of the figure "6p.".
- 3. Bye-law 181 (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure "2p." and the substitution therefor of the figure "4p.".
- 4. Bye-law 186 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure "£2" and the substitution therefor of the figure "£10".

The above Bye-laws have been approved by the Colonial Secretary.
