No. 556. THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION LAW. CAP. 98 AND LAWS 23 OF 1950 AND 3 OF 1953.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Law, His Excellency Cap. 98 the Governor has been pleased to order that during the period preceding 23 of 1950 the 31st day of July, 1955, every holder of a game licence shall kill or cause to be killed four crows or magpies, or pay ten shillings for each crow or magpie short of such number, for the purposes of the aforementioned section of the Law.
