THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 92 AND LAW 16 OF 1954.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Foreshore Protection Law (Cap. 92) and Law 16 of 1954, I hereby give notice that except under a written permit from me and under such conditions as I may think fit to impose thereby—

- (1) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of foreshore described in the Schedule hereto; and
- (2) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto,

are absolutely prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

The foreshore commences at the Evdhimou jetty, locality "Stouppo", and proceeds eastwards and south-eastwards along the high-water mark to Cape Zevgari; thence eastwards to Cape Gata; thence north-westwards and northwards to the southern boundary of the foreshore described in the Notice published under Notification No. 88 in the Gazette No. 2420 of 1935, and includes any land within a distance of fifty yards of the said high-water mark throughout its length. The said foreshore is more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1616, a copy of which is available for inspection at the Office of the Commissioner, Limassol. No. 571. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW. CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Vasilia, in the District of Kyrenia, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

Rules made by the Village Health Commission of Vasilia under Section 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 (1) (c) of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Vasilia hereby make the following rules:—

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Vasilia) (Amendment) Rules, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Vasil'a) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Vasilia) Rules, 1938 and 1954.
- 2. Rule 86 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor:—
 - "Rule 86. There shall be paid by every occupier in the village in every year a rate not exceeding ten pounds to be assessed by the Village Health Commission according to the means of each such occupier".
