CAP. 43.

Revoker

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 35 (d).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 35 (d) of the Antiquities Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Antiquities (Admission Fees to Museums and Ancient Monuments) (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Antiquities (Admission Fees to Museums and Ancient Monuments) Regulations, 1950 to 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Antiquities (Admission Fees to Museums and Ancient Monuments) Regulations, 1950 to 1954.

2. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein, in its appropriate columns under the heading "Famagusta District" of the particulars set out in the columns of the Appendix hereto respectively.
