Order made under Section 22 (a) (i).

Authority to the Improvement Board of Galatia (Famagusta District) to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 22 (a) (i) of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, I, the Colonial Secretary, do hereby order as follows :—

I. The Improvement Board of Galatia (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lenders") a sum not exceeding one thousand five hundred pounds ($\pounds_{I,500}$) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Lenders in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Board for the asphalting of the main village streets.

2. For the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Board shall, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, mortgage to the Lenders all the rates, fees, rents, tolls or charges now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Board.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Assemblies, Meetings and Processions Law, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, do by this Order prohibit the holding between the 1st day of October, 1954 and the 15th day of October, 1954, both days inclusive, within the Districts of Nicosia and Kyrenia, of any assembly for the purpose of discussing the problems of the vine growers or of any other similar assembly arranged for the same period by the Vine Growers Committee of Limassol.
