The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Ayios Seryios, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF AYIOS SERIYIOS  
UNDER SECTION 9.

Cap. 142.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Ayios Seryios hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Ayios Seryios) (Amendment) Rules, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Ayios Seryios) Rules, 1938 and 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Ayios Seryios) Rules, 1938 to 1954.

2. Rules 20, 32, 46, 54 and 57 of the principal Rules are hereby repealed and the following Rules substituted therefor, respectively :—

*Rule 20.* The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say :—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox .. .. .	5	0
(b) for every goat, kid, lamb or sheep of 10 okes and above, carcass weight .. . . .	1	0
(c) for every goat, kid, lamb or sheep of 9 okes or under, carcass weight .. . . .	-	7

*Rule 32.* The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say :—

(a) per load of 50 okes or under, per day .. .. .	-	3
(b) per load of over 50 okes but not more than 100 okes, per day .. . . .	-	6
(c) per load of 100 okes above the first 100 okes, per day ..	-	3
(d) for every oke of fish .. . . .	-	1

*Rule 46.* The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

(a) for every carcass of bullock, camel, cow or ox .. .. .	5	0
(b) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 9 okes or under, carcass weight .. . . .	-	7
(c) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 9 okes, carcass weight .. . . .	1	0

*Rule 54.* The following fees shall be paid by any person exposing for sale any carcass of swine or fresh pork in the pork market, that is to say :—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) for every carcass of swine or portion of fresh pork of 50 okes or under, carcass weight .. . . .	5	0
(b) for every carcass of swine or portion of fresh pork above 50 okes, carcass weight .. . . .	10	0

*Rule 57.* The following fees shall be paid by any person exposing for sale any animal in the animal market, that is to say:—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow, ox, horse, donkey or mule	1	0
(b) for every sheep, goat, kid, lamb, ewe or ram of six months and over	..	3
(c) for every sheep, goat, kid, lamb, ewe or ram under six months	..	2
(d) for every swine of six months and over	..	6
(e) for every swine under six months	..	3

3. The following Rule shall be added immediately after rule 77.

“78. The following fee shall be paid by the owner or occupier of any premises for the removal by persons appointed by the Village Health Commission of buckets or receptacles containing household refuse or manure within the area of the village, that is to say:—

**No. 601. THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES LAW.**  
CAP. 311 AND LAWS 28 OF 1951 AND 12 OF 1952.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE WATER COMMISSION OF PYRGOS VILLAGE  
(LIMASSOL DISTRICT) UNDER SECTION 29.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 29 of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, the Water Commission of Pyrgos village, in the District of Limassol, hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Village Domestic Water Supply (Pyrgos) Bye-laws, 1954.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this bye-law, the Village Domestic Water Supply (Elea) Bye-laws, 1950, published in the *Gazette* of 1st November, 1950, shall—

- (a) be deemed to be bye-laws made by the Water Commission of Pyrgos and to be incorporated herein, and
- (b) apply to the village of Pyrgos.

(2) The bye-laws set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding bye-laws of the Village Domestic Water Supply (Elea) Bye-laws, 1950.

(3) Those bye-laws of the Village Domestic Water Supply (Elea) Bye-laws, 1950, mentioned in Part II of the Schedule hereto, shall not apply to the village of Pyrgos.

SCHEDULE.

PART I.

(Bye-law 2 (2)).

BYE-LAWS TO BE SUBSTITUTED.

*Bye-law 2.*—In these bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the District of Limassol and includes an Assistant Commissioner of that District;

“Law” means the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law and any law amending or substituted for the same;

“Village” means the village of Pyrgos;

“Water” means the water of the water supply;

“Water Commission” means the Water Commission of Pyrgos village;

“Water Supply” means the supply of water for domestic purposes used or constructed under the Law in the village of Pyrgos and includes all wells, bores, reservoirs, dams, weirs, tanks, cisterns, tunnels, filter beds, conduits, aqueducts, mains, pipes, fountains, sluices, valves, pumps, channels, engines and other structures or appliances used or constructed for the storage, conveyance, supply, distribution, measurement or regulation of the water of such supply of water.
