Bye-laws made by the Council of the Municipal Corporation OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations' Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws:-

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Limassol Municipal (Amendment 20 of 1933)

2. Bye-laws 1054 and shall be read as approved the Limassol Municipal (Amendment 20 of 1933) No. 3) Bye-laws, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Limassol Municipal Bye-laws, 1953 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Supplement Limassol Municipal Bye-laws, 1953 and 1954.

2. The principal bye-laws are hereby amended by the deletion of items 7 and 8 of the First Schedule to the principal bye-laws and the substitution therefor of the following items:

7. Carobs, natural or ground 1 piastre per cantar

8. Carobs, natural or ground, on exportation outside the Colony 6 piastres per cantar."
