THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

Appointment of Members under Section 7.

J. Fletcher-Cooke, Governor's Deputy.

Whereas the area of Troodos, being an area deemed to have been declared under the provisions of section 3 (2) of the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, as a summer resort for the purposes of the aforesaid Cap. 255. Law, is deemed, under the provisions of section 3 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, to have been declared to be an improvement area and is such an area for the purposes of the last mentioned Laws:

And whereas it is necessary to appoint members of the Board of such

improvement area:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 7 (1) of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, I, the Governor's Deputy do hereby appoint the following persons to be members of the Improvement Board of Troodos to hold office for a period of four years from the 30th day of October, 1954, unless their appointment is previously terminated by the Governor-

(a) The Conservator of Forests or his representative;
(b) The Director of Information Services or his representative;

(c) A representative of the Officer Commanding Cyprus District.

THE WATER SUPPLY (MUNICIPAL AND OTHER AREAS) LAWS, 1951 AND 1952.

Notification under Section 18 (4).

Whereas the Water Board of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") have, by a unanimous resolution, passed under section 18 (1) of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 and 1952, decided that certain immovable property specified therein should be acquired for the purpose of preventing the use of the two boreholes situated therein in the interests of the water supply of the town of Famagusta;
