No. 634. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW. CAP. 142.

The following rules, made by the Village Health Commission of Avgorou, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the Gazette.

Rules made by the Village Health Commission of Avgorou under SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Avgorou hereby make the following rules :---

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Avgorou) (Amendment) Rules, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Avgorou) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Avgorou) Rules, 1938 and 1954.

2. Rules 20, 46 and 54 of the principal Rules are hereby repealed and the following Rules substituted therefor, respectively :-

Rule 20. The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say :-

- (a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox ... 25.
- (b) for every goat, kid, lamb, sheep or ram of 10 okes and above carcass weight ... IS.
- (c) for every goat, kid, lamb or sheep of under 10 okes of carcass weight ÷., . . · . . · · · . .

6p. Rule 46. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:-

- (a) for every carcass of bullock, camel, cow or ox 25. . . (b) for every carcass of goat, sheep, ram, kid or lamb of 10
- okes and above carcass weight.. 15. (c) for every carcass of goat, sheep, ram, kid or lamb of under

10 okes carcass weight • • . . 6p. Rule 54. The following fees shall be paid by any person exposing for

- sale any carcass of swine or fresh pork in the pork market, that is to say :-(a) for every carcass of swine or portion of fresh pork of 40 okes
 - or under carcass weight IS. (b) for every carcass of swine or portion of fresh pork of 80 okes or under carcass weight 25.
 - (c) for every carcass of swine or portion of fresh pork above 80 okes carcass weight
