No. 661. THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) LAW. CAP. 65.

Order under Section 4 (1) (l).

In exercise of the powers vested in the [Governor by section 4 (1) (l) of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Law, Cap. 65, duly deputed to me under section 6 of the said Law by paragraph 3 of Notification No. 527 published in the *Gazette* of the 3rd July, 1931, I, Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby order as follows:—

- (1) The area of Athalassa and the village areas of Yeri and Eylenja are declared Oestrus Ovis (sheep nostril fly) infected areas.
- (2) All sheep and goats in these village areas shall be treated by intrasinus injection for the destruction of larvae of the sheep nostril fly.
- (3) The treatments shall be carried out by Veterinary Officers or by such Vaccinators as may be appointed by me in writing.
- (4) Every owner or person in charge of sheep or goats shall produce such sheep or goats for treatment at such place and at such time as shall be appointed by a Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator as aforesaid by notice posted in a conspicuous place in the village concerned, and every such owner or person in charge shall render full assistance to the Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator in the treatment of the sheep or goats as aforesaid.
