## THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

Notice under Section 6.

With reference to the Notification No. 664 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 25th November, 1954, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein:—

All the privately-owned lands situated within the area represented by the area edged red on the Government Survey Plan signed by the Director of Public Works and dated the 25th November, 1954, which area is within the limits of Limassol town and is bounded approximately by the new Feeder road and the Garyllis river to the north and east, the Tragasol Carob Mill, Kassabkhane street and the sea to the south and the Brick and Tile factory to the west.

- 2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.
  - 3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.
- 4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.
