THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
ACT, 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as extended to the Colony by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Colonies, etc.) Order in Council, 1946, which continues in force under the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1953, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Importation of Goods) (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 to 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 to 1954.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Financial Secretary" for the words "Colonial Secretary", wherever the latter words occur.

3. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Financial Secretary" for the words "Colonial Secretary".

(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 3 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1953, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to appoint the Financial Secretary to be a competent Authority in the place of the Colonial Secretary for the purposes of Defence Regulations 61 and 61A as set out in the aforesaid Schedule.

2. The appointment made on the 16th day of January, 1951, and published under Notification No. 18 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 17th January, 1951, is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to Defence Regulations 61 and 61A.
