THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Notification No. 32 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 21st January, 1954, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All those areas of privately-owned land, situated in the village of Kolossi in the District of Limassol, at the localities Phinidji and Phtana tou Phinidjou comprising 3 donums, 3 eyleks and 400 sq. ft. or thereabouts, including parts of Plots Nos. 58/39, 58/38, 58/37, 58/26, 58/31, 58/32 and 58/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. LVIII.14, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan marked AKROTIRI AIRFIELD WATER SUPPLY dated 23rd October, 1954, and signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings and Disposals (Fixed Assets) H.Q., Cyprus District.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.
