## THE MOTOR CAR REGULATIONS, 1951 TO 1954.

APPOINTMENT UNDER REGULATION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 4 of the Motor Car

Regulations, 1951 to 1954, I do hereby appoint-

(a) the Accountant-General as a Deputy Registrar for the purpose of controlling the registration and licensing of motor cars and the issue or renewal of drivers' licences as provided in Parts II, III and IV of the aforementioned Regulations;

(b) the Officer in charge of the Police Traffic Branch, Nicosia, as a Deputy Registrar to carry out and exercise all the duties and powers vested in me under the aforementioned Regulations except my

power under Regulation 40;

(c) the Police Officers for the time being in charge of the Limassol, Famagusta, Larnaca, Paphos and Kyrenia Police Divisions to carry out and exercise the following duties and powers vested in me under the aforementioned Regulations in their respective Divisions:—

(i) to issue temporary licences under Regulation 42;

(ii) to issue licences for projecting loads under Regulation 45 (n), for excess passengers under Regulations 46 (g) and 47, and for excess goods or luggage on roof under Regulation 53 (1) (s).

2. The Notification published under No. 237 in Supplement No. 3 to the Cyprus Gazette of the 9th May, 1953, is hereby cancelled.
