No. 718. THE AGRICULTURAL FERTILIZERS LAW.
CAP. 37 AND LAW II OF 1954.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION II.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 11 of the Agricultural Fertilizers Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Fertilizers (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Fertilizers Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-regulation (the existing regulation being numbered as sub-regulation (1)) :—

"(2) The sacks of imported or locally prepared or mixed fertilizers shall be of a standard gross weight of one kilo, five kilos, fifty kilos or one hundred kilos :

Provided that the Director of Agriculture may, in his discretion, authorize in writing the sale of fertilizers in sacks of weights other than the weights specified in this sub-regulation."

3. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "lead" (line 1) of the word "metal".

4. The Appendix to the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by the substitution for the word "Net" of the word "Gross" wherever the said word occurs therein ;
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the symbols "N", "P₂O₅" and "K₂O" wherever they occur therein ;
- (c) by the substitution of the following Note for Note 1 thereof :—

"Note 1—

In the above forms—

- (i) the figure "6" denotes total nitrogen of 6 per centum ;
- (ii) the first figure "8" denotes ammonium nitrate soluble phosphoric acid of 8 per centum ;
- (iii) the second figure "8" denotes total potash of 8 per centum".

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to the Notification No. 595 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 7th October, 1954, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All those areas of privately-owned land, situated in the town of Ktima, comprising 1 donum and 800 square feet or thereabouts, including plots No. 1057/2, 1058, 1059, 1060, 1061, 1063 and 1062 of the Government Survey Plan of Ktima Town more particularly defined as the areas coloured red on the Government Survey Plan marked PAPHOS COURTS, dated the 6th November, 1954, and signed by the Director of Public Works.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my Office.
