In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 (1) of the Antiquities Law (Cap. 43), I, the Governor, on the recommendation of the Director of Antiquities, and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby direct that such part of the ancient monument specified as item 4 of the Famagusta District in the Second Schedule to the said Law (relating to the Glacis of Famagusta) as is marked "A" and edged blue on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1594, copy of which has been deposited with the Commissioner of Famagusta and the Director of Antiquities, be transferred from the Second Schedule to the said Law to the First Schedule thereto as part of item 13 of the Famagusta District.

No. 84. THE CONSULAR CONVENTIONS LAW, 1952.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2667

MADE UNDER SECTION 8 (1).

Whereas by section 8 (1) of the Consular Conventions Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") it is enacted that the Governor may, by Order in Council, direct that sections 2, 4, 6 or 7 of the Law shall apply to any foreign State specified in the Order, being a State with which a Consular Convention providing for matters for which provision is made by those sections has been concluded by Her Majesty;

And whereas a Consular Convention (hereinafter referred to as "the Convention") between His late Majesty King George the Sixth in respect
