

No. 147. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to the Notification No. 62 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 3rd February, 1955, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Grain Commission for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :

All that area of privately owned land, situated in the village of Beyuk Kaimakli, in the District of Nicosia, at the locality " Trakhonas ", comprising 31 donums and 1,300 square feet or thereabout, including plots Nos. 90, 133, 171, 172, 173 and 174 of Block F, Beyuk Kaimakli, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked " GRAIN COMMISSION SILOS AND PITS, BEYUK KAIMAKLI " signed by the Chairman, Cyprus Grain Commission, dated 16th February, 1955, and deposited in the Commissioner's office, Nicosia.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within ten days from the date of publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Grain Commission is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.

No. 148. THE VILLAGE AUTHORITIES LAW.
CAP. 256 AND LAW 17 OF 1951.
