CAP. 3.

AUTHORIZATION UNDER SECTION 11 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section II (I) of the Advocates Law, I do hereby authorize—

- (a) all District Medical Officers,
- (b) all Medical Officers,
- (c) the Chief Health Inspector,
- (d) all District Health Inspectors,
- (e) the Medical Officer in charge of the Athienou Health Unit, and
- (f) the Health Inspector in charge of the Athienou Health Unit to appear, plead and act in any proceedings under the following Laws and any subsidiary legislation made thereunder:—
 - (a) The Public Health (Anti-Malaria) Law (Cap. 139).
 - (b) the Criminal Code (Cap. 13), so far as it relates to sections 184 to 187, both inclusive.
 - (c) The Quarantine Law (Cap. 145).
 - (d) The Sale of Food and Drugs Law (Cap. 151).
 - (e) Any Order, Notification or Regulations made under the Disease Prevention Law, 1883.
 - (f) The Public Health (Villages) Law (Cap. 142).
 - (g) The Defence (Public Health) Regulations, 1941.
- 2. The authorization published under Notification No. 239 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 9th October, 1941, is hereby revoked.
