THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW. CAP. 165 AND LAW 10 OF 1950.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, I, the Commissioner of Limassol, as the appropriate authority under section 3 (2) (b) of the aforesaid Law, do hereby with the approval of the Governor, define the area described in Schedule "A" hereto as a zone within which no buildings of a lesser value than $\pounds 2,500$ shall be erected, and the areas described in Schedule "B" hereto as a zone within which no buildings of a lesser value than $\pounds 1,500$ shall be erected, provided always that the aforementioned minimum values shall not include the value of the building site.

Schedule "A".

All that area of land in the villages of Pano Polemidhia, Kato Polemidhia and Ayia Phyla in the District of Limassol, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1619.
