**THE WATER SUPPLY (MUNICIPAL AND OTHER AREAS) LAWS,
1951 AND 1952.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 18 (4).

Whereas the Water Board of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") have, by a unanimous resolution, passed under section 18 (1) of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 and 1952, decided that certain immovable property specified therein should be acquired for the purpose of constructing a road therein in the interests of the water supply of the town of Famagusta ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Famagusta, as Chairman of the Board, by notice published under Notification No. 518 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th August, 1954, and posted at a conspicuous place within the area concerned on the 11th August, 1954, gave under section 18 (2) of the aforesaid Laws particulars of the immovable property required (hereinafter referred to as "the immovable property") ;

And whereas at the expiration of the period set out in the said notice the Chairman of the Board forwarded to the Governor all the documents required under section 18 (1) of the aforesaid Laws together with six objections made against the proposed acquisition ;

And whereas in the meantime three of the objectors, namely Maria Nicola, Eleni Hadjitoffi and Paraskevou Theori, all of Phrenaros, have agreed to sell to the Board their immovable properties, particulars of which are given in the notice referred to above ;

And whereas I, the Governor, have approved the plan submitted and have considered it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that the Board should be permitted to acquire the immovable property, other than the immovable property which has already been acquired by agreement :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 18 (4) of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 and 1952, I do hereby sanction the acquisition of the immovable property, other than the immovable property which has already been acquired by agreement, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws.
