

No. 193. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas the Cyprus Grain Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") has, by a unanimous resolution, decided that certain immovable property specified therein should be acquired for the purpose of constructing thereon grain silos and pits for underground storage, an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Commissioner, Nicosia, by notice published under Notification No. 147 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 3rd March, 1955 (copies of which were served on each of the owners of the said immovable property) gave particulars of the immovable property required (hereinafter referred to as "the immovable property") ;

And whereas at the expiration of the period set out in the said notice the Commissioner, Nicosia, forwarded to the Governor recommendations, plans and particulars, together with two objections made against the proposed acquisition ;

And whereas I, the Governor, have approved the plan submitted and have considered it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that the immovable property be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the immovable property under the provisions of the aforesaid Law.
