And whereas the Governor in Council is satisfied that the provision of water supplies for the area of supply and the conservation of water resources for the purpose of such provision may be more effectively secured by the inclusion of the area described in the Schedule hereto within the area of supply :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 to 1954, and of every other power thereunto enabling, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to declare that the area described in the Schedule hereto shall be an area of supply for the purposes of the said Laws and form part of the area of supply declared by the principal Order and that that area and the area described in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be one area of supply for the purposes of the principal Order and the said Laws.

SCHEDULE.

*Area of Supply.*

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 244/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIV.57, at which point the diversion of the Garyllis river begins and proceeds north-eastwards in a straight line to the north eastern corner of plot No. 97 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIV.50, locality "Perdhikos" ; thence eastwards in a straight line to the most northern point of plot No. 21 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIV.51, locality "Throumberi" ; thence south-westwards in a straight line to the point of commencement, all which boundary of the said area of supply is shown edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1626.
