BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF
FAMAGUSTA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta hereby make the following bye-laws:—

These bye-laws may be cited as the Famagusta Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1955.
