THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW. CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

Notice under Sections 2, 3 and 5.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to carry out certain alterations, extension and improvements (hereinafter referred to as the "alterations, extension and improvements") to certain land and buildings (that is to say the premises formerly used as the Gymnasium of Limassol and as the First Boys' Elementary School) intended for use in future as the Divisional Police Headquarters and Town Station at Limassol:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the carrying out of the alterations, extension and improvements to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Public Works.
