No. 356. SEDITIOUS PUBLICATIONS LAW.
CAP. 156.

PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 4 (1).

R. P. ARMITAGE,

Whereas by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Seditious Publications Law it is provided that whenever the Governor-in-Council is of opinion that any publication is seditious, the Governor-in-Council may, if he thinks fit, by proclamation published in the *Gazette*, prohibit the importation into Cyprus of that publication and also, in the case of a periodical publication, of any past or future issue of that publication :

And whereas the Governor-in-Council is of opinion that the publications set out in the Schedule hereto are seditious :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sub-section (1) of the said section 4 of the Seditious Publications Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order and proclaim that the importation into Cyprus of the publications set out in the Schedule hereto, and where any such publication is a periodical publication, of any past or future issue of such publication, shall be prohibited.
