THE DEFENCE (IMPORTATION OF GOODS) REGULATIONS, 1943 TO 1954.

OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE No. 8400.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 to 1954, I hereby grant to any importer registered under the provisions of the Defence (Registration of Importers and Resellers) Order, 1954, an Open General Import Licence under No. 8400 to import into the Colony in any quantity any of the goods enumerated in the Schedule hereto and originating in any of the following countries and exported from such country of origin:-

Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Persia, Sudan and Syria:

Provided that in all cases covered by this licence payment for the goods shall be made in sterling.

2. This Open General Import Licence is deemed to be a written licence issued by me under Regulation 2 (i) (a) of the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 to 1954, and is subject to the provisions of Regulation 2 (i) (b) of the said Regulations.

SCHEDULE.

The Divisions, Groups and Items set out in the second column of this Schedule refer to the Divisions, Groups and Items, respectively, which are set out in the Standard International Trade Classification, published in United Nations Statistical Papers Series M.
