## PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 11.

R. P. ARMITAGE,

Governor.

Whereas by section 11 of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Law it is provided that where the Governor is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Legislature of any British possession or any territory under Her Majesty's protection for the enforcement within such possession or territory of maintenance orders made by Courts in Cyprus, the Governor may by proclamation extend the said Law to such possession or territory;

And whereas I am satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia for the enforcement within the Northern Territory of Australia of maintenance orders made by Courts in Cyprus:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the said section 11 of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Law, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby order and proclaim that the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Law shall extend to the Northern Territory of Australia as from the 28th day of April, 1955.

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW. CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to establish and maintain a military cantonment within the town of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as the Famagusta cantonment) the cost whereof is to be borne by Her Majesty's Military Authorities:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, do hereby declare the establishment of the Famagusta cantonment to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorise the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to Mr. Percy George Crosbye Farrell, M.B.E., the Assistant Director of Hirings and Disposals (Fixed Assets), Cyprus District, or in his absence to the person acting for the time being as Assistant Director of Hirings and Disposals (Fixed Assets), Cyprus District.
