It is hereby notified that the port workers' side of the Port Labour Board Suppl. No. 3: of Larnaca has nominated Mr. Suleiman Hussein Zugurt as a representative member of the said Board in the place of Mr. Hassan Ozturk and that the constitution of the said Board has been amended accordingly.

The constitution of the said Board is hereby further amended by the deletion of the name of Mr. Edmund Murat, deceased (nominated by the employers' side) and of the name of Mr. Thalis Djivas (nominated (M.P. 1522/53.) by the port workers' side).

No. 409. HOTELS, LODGING HOUSES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS (REGULATION) LAW. CAP. 105.

Bye-laws made by the Municipal Council of Paphos under Section 4. Whereas by Order-in-Council No. 2602 published under Notification No. 125 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 12th March, 1953, the Hotels, Lodging Houses and Public Buildings (Regulation) Law has been applied to hotels, lodging houses and public buildings situated within the limits of all municipal corporations:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in them, the Municipal Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos hereby make the

following Bye-laws:-

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Hotels, Lodging Houses and Public Buildings (Paphos) Bye-laws, 1955, and shall come into operation on the

1st day of July, 1955.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this bye-law, the Hotels, Lodging Houses and Public Buildings (Nicosia) Bye-laws, 1955, published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 28th April, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the model bye-laws"), shall-

(a) be deemed to be bye-laws made by the Municipal Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos and to be incorporated herein,

(b) apply to the hotels, lodging houses and public buildings within the municipal limits of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos: Provided that for the word "Nicosia" wherever it occurs in the model bye-laws the word "Paphos" shall be substituted.

(2) The bye-law set out in the First Appendix hereto shall be substituted

for the corresponding bye-law of the model bye-laws.

FIRST APPENDIX. (Bye-law 20).

It shall be the duty of the owner or person in charge of any hotel or public building to cause all food and all articles intended, exposed or offered for food or sale for human consumption to be protected from flies and other insects, dust and vermin by keeping them in well closed clean receptacles and to be handled by clean hands and by persons in possession of a valid certificate of health issued under Bye-laws 124 to 128 (both inclusive) of the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1955, or any Bye-law amending or substituted for the same.

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 1078/55.)
