#### THE POST OFFICE LAW. CAP. 281 AND LAW 44 OF 1953.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2769

#### MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

Cap. 281 44 of 1953. In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Post Office Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Order, 1955.

2. The respective rates of postage and charges set forth in the First Schedule hereto shall be charged by the Postmaster-General on all postal packets conveyed or delivered for conveyance by post.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1955, and thereupon the Post Office Notice and Orders in Council set out in the Second Schedule hereto shall be revoked.
