THE POST OFFICE LAW.

CAP. 281 AND LAW 44 OF 1953.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2769

MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

Cap. 281
44 of 1953.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Post Office Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Order, 1955.

2. The respective rates of postage and charges set forth in the First Schedule hereto shall be charged by the Postmaster-General on all postal packets conveyed or delivered for conveyance by post.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1955, and thereupon the Post Office Notice and Orders in Council set out in the Second Schedule hereto shall be revoked.

THE POST OFFICE LAW.

CAP. 281 AND LAW 44 OF 1953.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2770

MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Post Office Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rates of Postage) Order, 1955. *Cap 281*
44 of 1953.
2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the third, fourth, fifth and sixth columns of the Schedule hereto, on letters, postcards, second class mail and newspapers, and a combined Postage and Air fee at the rate set forth in the seventh column of the said Schedule on air parcels, intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, through the route set out in the second column thereof opposite each country.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1955, and thereupon the Post Office (Special Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1939, the Post Office (Civilian Air Letter Rate of Postage) Order, 1944, and the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, (No. 2) 1953, shall be revoked. *Gazettes :*
