NOTICE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Prison Discipline Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to approve Cap. 266. and direct that the Schedule to the Notice published under Notification No. 1 of 1953. 254 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th July, 1950, be amended by the addition thereto opposite the words "Paphos District" of the word "Paphos".

2. The aforesaid amendment shall be deemed to have taken effect as from the 1st day of July, 1955.
