THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District) Order, 1955.
- 2. No person within the area of Strovolos Improvement Area shall be out of doors between the hours of 4 a.m. on Tuesday, the 6th September, 1955, and 4 a.m. on Wednesday, the 7th September, 1955, except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Nicosia/Kyrenia or Superintendent of Police or Assistant Superintendent of Police of Nicosia:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

3. The Superintendent of Police of Nicosia is hereby authorized to suspend at his absolute discretion the operation within the area of Strovolos Improvement Area (or any part thereof) of this Order, and similarly to terminate such suspension and to declare this Order to be in operation.
