THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE. REGULATION 64.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1954), I do by this Order order as follows :--

1. I authorise, subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of six months fron the date of this Order.

2. The persons using the land are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes of its occupation.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.

2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon.

3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest on the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All those areas of privately owned lands situated in the village of Kato Polemidhia and in Chiftlikler Quarter, Limassol Town, consisting of 111 donums, 2 evleks and 1,600 square feet or thereabouts and including parts of plots Nos. 232/1; 232/2, 233; 234 and 257 of Government Survey Plan LVIII.8, 174/1, 175, 176/1, 176/2 and 178 of Government Survey Plan LIV.57, and 1, 2, 3, 4, 13, 14, 15/2, 15/3, 16, 17/1, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, 31/1, 35, 36/2, 37/1, 37/3/1, 37/3/2, 38, 39/1, 39/2 and 40/1 of Government Survey Plan LIX.1 and the whole of plots Nos. 17/2, 29/1 and 29/2 of Government Survey Plan LIX.1, more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1643, signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings, Cyprus, and dated the 13th September, 1955.
