THE STEAM BOILERS, ENGINES AND RECEIVERS LAW. CAP. 163.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 18.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 18 of the Steam Boilers, Cap. 163. Engines and Receivers Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Steam Boilers, Engines and S.L.I., 300. Receivers (Amendment) Regulations, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Steam Boilers, Engines and Receivers Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations").
 - 2. Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.
- 3. Regulation 17 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

Provided that in cases in which licences in respect of a number of boilers, receivers or engines at one and the same factory or mill, the property of the same owner may be required, there may be paid with the approval of the Secretary for Social Services, in lieu of the fees hereinbefore set out an annual inclusive fee covering all inspections made during the year in respect of which the inclusive fee is paid."
