THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District No. 3) Order, 1955.
- 2. No person within that area of Limassol Town described in Schedule I hereto shall be out of doors on the dates and during the hours prescribed in Schedule II except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Limassol or the Superintendent of Police or Assistant Superintendent of Police of Limassol:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 27th day of September, 1955.

SCHEDULE I.

- 1. Gladstone Street from the corner of Karaiskakis Street to the corner of Victor Hugo Street, and all premises abutting on the said street;
- 2. Zenon Street from the corner of Gladstone Street to the corner of Pavlos Melas Street, and all premises abutting on the said street;
- 3. Stassinos Street from the corner of George VI Street to the corner of Zenon Street, and all premises abutting on the said street;
- 4. Heroes Square, and all premises abutting on the said square.
