THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW. CAP. 92 AND LAW 16 OF 1954.

Notice under Section 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I hereby absolutely prohibit:

- (a) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto;
- (b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto;
- (c) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse into the sea at any point opposite to the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto within a distance of 200 yards from low water mark.

SCHEDULE.

Temblos Village.

The foreshore commences at the north-eastern corner of plot No. 205 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII.II.E, locality "Nissi", which corner is on the sea-shore and proceeds south-easterwards and eastwards along the high-water mark to the most northern point of plot No. 2/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII.12.W, locality "Nissi", and includes any land within a distance of fifty yards of the high-water mark throughout its length. The said foreshore is more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1642, deposited at the Office of the Commissioner, Kyrenia.

THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW.

CAP. 157.

Notice under Section 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 1st October and the 3rd November, 1955, flocks within the area of Ayios Iakovos village and Plousha Minor Forest, in the District of Famagusta, shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd from one village area to another, along any public road at any hour.
