THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Famagusta District No. 3) Order, 1955.
- 2. No person within the area of the municipal boundaries of Famagusta shall be out of doors between the hours of 6 p.m. on Thursday the 29th September, 1955, and 6 a.m. on Friday the 30th September, 1955, except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Famagusta or the Superintendent of Police or the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Famagusta:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 29th day of September, 1955.
