THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW. CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare that the Improvement Board of Peyia in the District of Paphos shall be recognized as a public body for the purposes of the aforesaid Law.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the provision of a piped water supply in the Improvement Area of Peyia and the acquisition of land in connection therewith to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the Chairman of the Improvement Board of Peyia with the supervision of the said undertaking.
