THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Paphos District No. 3) Order, 1955.
- 2. No person within the area of the village boundaries of Neokhorio shall be out of doors on the dates and during the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Paphos or the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Paphos:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

3. The Assistant Superintendent of Police of Paphos is hereby authorized to suspend at his absolute discretion the operation within the area of the above-mentioned village boundaries (or any part thereof) of this Order and similarly to terminate such suspension and to declare this Order to be in operation.

This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of October, 1955.
