

No. 65. THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS LAW:

CAP. 152 AND LAW 15 OF 1954.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 8 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 (1) of the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Order, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Order (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The Appendix to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein under the heading "Famagusta District", and in their proper alphabetical place, of the improvement areas of "Boghaz" and "Kantara".
