THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT)
LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF KAMBOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Kambos make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kambos (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kambos Bye-laws, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Bye-laws) and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kambos Bye-laws, 1951 and 1955.

2. Bye-law 93 (2) (d) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the following bye-law substituted therefor :—

“*Bye-law* 93 (2) (d) sell or expose for sale bread only in loaves weighing one kilogram or half a kilogram ;”
