APPOINTMENT OF RECEIVER UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Wrecks Law, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby appoint the Collector of Customs and Excise, Nicosia, to be Receiver of Wreck in the District of Nicosia and to perform the duties and exercise the powers vested in the Receiver under the aforesaid Law.
