## THIRD SCHEDULE.

1. The warehousing of any kind of goods.

2. Any trade or business in which articles are manufactured, altered, cleaned, washed, repaired, ornamented, finished, packed, canned, adapted for sale, broken up or demolished or in which materials are transformed, including the generation, transformation of electricity and motive power of any kind which, by reason of any process, carried on, machinery installed, traffic, noise, vibration, smell, fume, smoke, soot, ash, dust or grit made, caused or produced is detrimental to the amenities of any area other than an industrial area.

THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. LAWS 17 OF 1955 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District No. 20)

Order, 1955.

2. No person within the area of the Municipal boundaries of the town of Limassol shall be out of doors on the dates and during the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Limassol or the Senior Superintendent of Police, Limassol:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive

Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 28th day of October, 1955.

Between the hours of 5.00 a.m. on Friday the 28th October, 1955, until 11.30 a.m. and from 2.00 p.m. until 5.30 p.m.
