(a) For every load of goods of 30 okes or under .. ..	15
(b) For every load of goods over 30 okes .. ..	30
(c) For every motor-lorry or cart of goods .. ..	100

*Rule 45.* The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

	<i>Mils.</i>
(a) For every carcass of sheep or goat or part thereof ..	20
(b) For every carcass of a young lamb or kid or part thereof ..	20
(c) For every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof .. .. .	50

*Rule 56.* The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any foodstuffs in the market of foodstuffs, that is to say :—

	<i>Mils.</i>
(a) Per stall, per day .. .. .	50
(b) Per stand, per day .. .. .	20
(c) Per stall, per month .. .. .	250
