THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY (TENURE, REGISTRATION AND VALUATION) LAW.

CAP. 231 AND LAWS 8 OF 1953 AND 4 OF 1954.

Notice under Section 18 (c).

Whereas the communal property under plot No. 375 of the Government Survey Plan No. XL.10 comprising four donums of land or thereabouts is required for the establishment of a school garden for Lymbia village, Nicosia District, an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Village Commission of Lymbia, on behalf of the village community, have requested that the aforesaid communal property should cease to be communal property and be vested and registered in the name of the Chairman of the Village Commission for the aforesaid purpose, and have declared that they do not claim the assignment, in lieu of such communal property, of Crown property of equal utility as the said communal property or the payment of a sum equal to the value of the said communal property to be disposed for the benefit of the said village:
