

No. 746. THE BELLS (REGULATION) LAW.

CAP. 47.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Bells (Regulation) Law, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bells (Regulation) (Nicosia and Kyrenia Districts) Order, 1955.
2. The bells of every church situated within the Districts of Nicosia and Kyrenia may be sounded or rung solely for the purposes of any divine service customarily celebrated therein or of any baptism, wedding or funeral service whenever any such service is being held or is to be held in such church.
3. On any of the occasions specified in paragraph 2 hereof, the bells of every church may be sounded or rung at such times and for such periods and as often as it has been customary heretofore either immediately before or during or immediately after any divine service customarily celebrated therein or any baptism, wedding or funeral service.
4. Nothing herein contained shall affect or shall be construed as affecting the validity of any permit relating to the sounding or ringing of bells as time signals or for summoning children to school.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Bells (Regulation) Law, I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bells (Regulation) (Famagusta District) Order, 1955.
2. The bells of every church situated within the District of Famagusta may be sounded or rung solely for the purposes of any divine service customarily celebrated therein or of any baptism, wedding or funeral service whenever any such service is being held or is to be held in such church.
3. On any of the occasions specified in paragraph 2 hereof, the bells of every church may be sounded or rung at such times and for such periods and as often as it has been customary heretofore either immediately before or during or immediately after any divine service customarily celebrated therein or any baptism, wedding or funeral service.
4. Nothing herein contained shall affect or shall be construed as affecting the validity of any permit relating to the sounding or ringing of bells as time signals or for summoning children to school.
