No. 817. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.
NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 7 AND 16.

Whereas by Notification published under No. 89 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th February, 1954, the Governor declared under sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law the acquisition of certain lands near the North Glacis of the fortification of the Old Famagusta Town to be an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Commissioner, Famagusta, by a notice published under Notification No. 178 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 8th March, 1954, gave particulars of the properties (hereinafter referred to as "the properties") required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking ;

And whereas the Commissioner, Famagusta, forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plans and particulars ;

And whereas an award has been made in pursuance of the first proviso to section 8 of the Land Acquisition Law, a copy of which has been forwarded to the Administrative Secretary for the information of the Governor under the provisions of section 16 of the said Law ;

And whereas I, the Governor, have approved the plan and particulars submitted, and have considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the properties be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 7 and 16 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition, under the provisions of the said Law, of the properties.
