**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
ACT, 1945.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as extended to the Colony by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Colonies, etc.) Order in Council, 1946, which continues in force under the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1955, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Exportation of Goods) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Exportation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 to 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Defence (Exportation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 to 1955.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Director of Commerce and Industry" for the words "Financial Secretary" wherever the latter words occur.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1956.
