THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND
ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 13) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 41 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 41 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 13) 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Prohibition and Restriction of Publications) Order, 1956.

2. In this Order—

“the principal Regulations” means the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 13) 1956, and any Regulations amending the same;

“the proper authority” means the Press Censor or any Assistant Press Censor.

3. Upon receiving the direction of the Governor that as to any matter he is satisfied either—

- (i) that the publication, or
- (ii) that the unrestricted publication

thereof would or might be prejudicial to public safety or public order, the proper authority may, orally or in writing—

- (a) require any person not to publish in a newspaper any such matter either absolutely or until consent to the publication thereof is granted by the proper authority ; or
- (b) require any person to submit any such matter, before its publication in a newspaper, to the proper authority for his consent to the publication thereof ;
- (c) if consent to the publication of such matter be granted by the proper authority, require any person to publish the same in a newspaper in such form or manner as the proper authority may in and by such requirement specify.

4. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any requirement of the proper authority under this Order shall be guilty of an offence against the principal Regulations and shall be liable on conviction to the penalties provided for in Regulation 75 of the principal Regulations.

5. The provisions of this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of the principal Regulations.
