No. 1056. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952 AND 43 OF 1955.

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to His Excellency the Governor that it is desirable in the public interest to widen, improve and realign the public road between Limassol and M.P. 71 on the Limassol-Ktima Road by stages as may from time to time be decided (hereinafter referred to as the "road"):

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, His Excellency the Governor does hereby declare the widening, improving and realigning of the road to be an undertaking of public utility, and does hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking, under the provisions of the said Law, and does hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Public Works.
